- Share resident perspectives to inform Board discussions.
- Participate in Board decision-making.
- Monitor organisational performance, finances and risk.
- Uphold London CLT's values and community-led ethos.
- Act as an ambassador for London CLT.
- Serve on a Board committee where appropriate.

As with all Board Members, you will act in the best interests of London CLT as a whole while bringing your valuable lived experience to Board discussions.

What we're looking for

We're looking for people who:

- Live in a London CLT home.
- Share our commitment to permanently affordable housing.
- Want to make a positive contribution to London CLT's future.
- Are willing to work collaboratively with fellow Board Members.
- Can think strategically while bringing a resident perspective.

Previous Board experience is not required.

We value your lived experience and will provide all the support and induction needed to help you succeed.

Time commitment

The role is voluntary and unpaid.

Typical commitments include:

- Four Board meetings each year (primarily online).
- Participation in a Board committee where appropriate.
- Attendance at the Annual General Meeting.
- Reading Board papers before meetings.
- Occasional site visits, strategic workshops and events.

Support and induction

Every new Board Member receives:

- A structured induction.

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- Meetings with Board Members and staff.
- Governance and strategy documents.
- Site visits.
- Ongoing mentoring and support.

No previous governance experience is required.

Appointment

Resident Board Members are normally co-opted by the Board before being formally elected by members at the Annual General Meeting, in accordance with the Society's Rules.
